One log-in access

Two Washington State public health emergency response systems have been unified in one new website. WAresponds.org is a gateway to both the:

- Emergency messaging and alerting system.
- Public health volunteer registration system.

WA SECURES

WA SECURES has been the state's public health alerting site for several years and is used to send messages to local public health jurisdictions, tribes and emergency response partners statewide. This system, originally intended to deliver Health Alert Network (HAN) messages from the CDC, has grown to accommodate messaging and call-downs to local and specialized groups, data sharing and document collaboration, and ongoing emergency response training.

System changes now allow users to respond and confirm messages from more browsers and mobile devices than ever before – including text messaging. Along with other flexible messaging options, users may also retrieve passwords, and send links and attachments with alerts.

WAserv

WAserv is the new registration and contact system for emergency volunteers. Part of a national initiative, WAserv allows medical, public health and other emergency response professionals to pre-register as emergency volunteers.
